DISCUSSION

County Commission met with Paul and Karen Nosovitch to discuss an easement needed to finish Big Horn Drive Roundabout.

MOTION -

Commissioner Wrigley made a motion to agree to pay the Nosovitch \$2,000.00 and build a berm to be used as a barrier on their property. In return, the Nosovitchs will give the county the easement they need to complete the Big Horn Drive improvement project. Commissioner Ellinger seconded the motion.
