MEETING MINUTES OF MARCH 09, 2006

BUSINESS:

Stop Signs at Railroad Crossings - Old Stage Road and Nilges Road

- Current Status: Since MoDOT and Union Pacific Railroad installed the crossing gates and lights, the stop signs have been removed. There is still a "Stop Ahead" sign in place.
- Staff Recommendation: It is the staff opinion that the court order for the stop signs at both locations be rescinded and that the "Stop Ahead" sign be removed.
- Action Taken: Motion to recommend that the Cole County Commission rescind the court order for the stop signs at both locations and that the "Stop Ahead" sign be removed was made by Don Schnieders and seconded by Thomas Holt. Motion passed unanimously.

Stop Signs at the Intersection of St. Michaels Road and Old Route C

- Current Status: This is currently a two way stop with signs on St. Michaels Road.

- Staff Recommendation: It is the staff opinion that the intersection should be made a four way stop due to a sight distance problem. Two stop signs would be added on Old Route C.
- Action Taken: Motion to recommend that the intersection at St. Michaels Road and Old Route C be made a four way stop by adding stop signs on Old Route C was made by Don Schnieders and seconded by Thomas Holt. Motion passed unanimously.

John Rodemann reminded the committee that Proposition A (Cole County ½-cent Sales Tax Project) will be before the voters on August 8, 2006. Larry Benz gave a presentation of the history and success of this program and what the future projects would be should the tax be passed by the voters of the county.

Chairman John Rodemann announced that the next meeting is scheduled for September 14, 2006.

Motion that the meeting be adjourned made by Don Schnieders and seconded by Thomas Holt.
