COLE COUNTY, MO – The Cole County Health Department (CCHD) is working collaboratively with local Health Care providers to follow the state vaccination plan regarding COVID-19 vaccination efforts. Currently, COVID-19 vaccination efforts are focused on Phase 1A, which includes health care workers that interact directly with patients. As vaccine availability increases and all Phase 1A workers have been vaccinated, all vaccine providers in the State of Missouri will transition to Phase 1B individuals. CCHD does not have an estimated timeframe for the transition between phases. Those who are included in Phase 1B will include high risk populations, essential workers and first responders.
